➤ **NYS residency eligibility requirement** for recipients of awards administered by HESC is waived for a member of or spouse or dependent of a member of the USAF who is on full- time active duty and stationed in New York State. ➤ **NYS Math & Science Teaching Incentive Scholarship**

➤ **NYS Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant**

➤ **NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)**

Helps eligible NY residents pay tuition at approved schools in NYS. Annual TAP awards can be up to \$5,165.00. Because TAP is a grant – it does not have to be paid back. For additional information visit [www.hesc.ny.gov](http://www.hesc.ny.gov)

➤ **NYS Excelsior Scholarship**

The program covers tuition for eligible SUNY and CUNY students. The program will be phased in over three years, beginning in Fall 2017. It would first apply to families who earn \$100,000 or less, then to those who earn \$110,000 or less in 2018, and eventually reaching \$125,000 or less in 2019. ➤ **NYS Enhanced Tuition Award**

This program enables NY students attending private not-for-profit colleges in NY to receive financial assistance to complete their college degree. The program provides a maximum award of \$3,000, requires private colleges to provide a match and freeze student tuition for the duration of the award – maximizing the financial benefit to the student.
