> NYS STEM Incentive Program

Provides full SUNY or CUNY tuition scholarship for top 10 percent of NYS high school students if pursuing STEM degree and work in a STEM field in NYS for 5 years. For additional information visit www.hesc.ny.gov

> NYS Math & Science Teaching Incentive Scholarship

> NYS Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant

Grants up to \$4,000.00 per year to students in exchange for service at public or private elementary or secondary schools that serve students from low-income families. For more information visit www.hesc.ny.gov

> NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)

Helps eligible NY residents pay tuition at approved schools in NYS. Annual TAP awards can be up to \$5,165.00. Because TAP is a grant it does not have to be paid back. For additional information visit www.hesc.ny.gov

> NYS Excelsior Scholarship

The program covers tuition for eligible SUNY and CUNY students. For the fall 2018, families who earn \$110,000 or less are eligible. The Excelsior Scholarship application is now available and the deadline is July 23, 2018. Applications must be filed online, https://www.hesc.ny.gov/excelsior.

> NYS Enhanced Tuition Award

This program enables NY students attending private not-for-profit colleges in NY to receive financial assistance to complete their college degree. The program provides a maximum award of \$3,000, requires private colleges to provide a match and freeze student tuition for the duration of the award – maximizing the financial benefit to the student. The Enhanced Tuition Award application is now available and the deadline is July 31, 2018.
