New York State Education Law requires that BMI and weight status group be included as part of the student's school health examination. Each year a sample of school districts are selected to take part in a survey by the New York State Department of Health. The Huntington School District has been selected to take part in a survey by the New York State Department of Health in the fall of the 2017-18 school year. Since our school district has been selected to be part of the survey, we will be reporting to New York State Department of Health information about our students' weight status groups. The survey information assists health officials to develop programs that make it easier for children to be healthier. The survey only collects Body Mass Index (BMI) for submission to New York State. No names or information about individual students are disclosed. You may choose, however, to not have your child's BMI data included in this report by completing and sending a signed opt out letter (or form attached) to your school nurse on or before December 1, 2017.

**BMI Weight Status Survey Report to be submitted to New York State Health Department
During the 2017-18 School Year**

BMI Survey Data Opt Out Procedure

As part of a required school health examination (that are required Grades K, 2, 4, 7 and 10, as well as all new entrants), a student is weighed and his/her height is measured. These numbers are used to figure out the student's body mass index or "BMI". The BMI helps the doctor or nurse know if the student's weight is in a healthy range or is too high or too low. Changes to the New York State Education Law require that BMI and weight status group be included as part of the student's school health examination. Each year a sample of school districts are selected to take part in a survey by the New York State Department of Health. The Huntington School District has been selected to take part in a survey by the New York State Department of Health in the fall of the 2017-18 school year. Since our school district has been selected to be part of the survey, we will be reporting to New York State Department of Health information about our students' weight status groups. Only BMI aggregate data is included on the survey that is reported to the New York State Department of Health. **No names and no information** about individual students are sent. However, you may choose to have your child's information excluded (opt out) from this survey report.

The information sent to the New York State Department of Health will help health officials develop programs that make it easier for children to be healthier.
