Dear Parents and Guardians,

Huntington UFSD will be providing all students in grades 7-12 a Chromebook, a protective case and a power cord. Students and parents **who have not signed a Chromebook user agreement** in the past need to sign one before their child can receive his or her Chromebook this year (this mainly applies to 7th, 11th and 12th graders and students new to the district). The agreement is on the school website and can be downloaded and printed out, or it can be obtained in the main office of your child's school.

Additionally, Huntington UFSD has purchased Chromebook Insurance for all the 1 to 1 devices that have been purchased during this year and last; namely Lenovo N22 devices (current 8th grade students) and Lenovo Yoga devices (grades: 7, 9-12). The devices are now insured against breakage, spills and cracked screens. **We continue to emphasize that the devices should be kept in their protective cases and should be handled with care.** If a student breaks his or her device he or she will be given a temporary loaner to use until the repair is made. Procedures will be forthcoming. Students who have multiple breakages will lose the privilege of taking the device home.

Our goal is to offer students 21st Century skills and learning opportunities that are independent of time and location. Digital citizenship and collaborative work are crucial elements for future success.
