EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING:

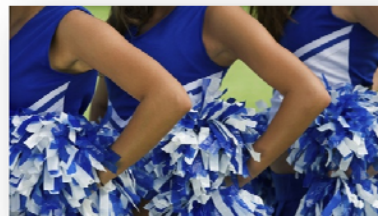
