COMMUNICATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mr. Palacios congratulated the Huntington High School Golf team for their 10 and 0 season. They have qualified for the county competition. Mr. Palacios attended the Hispanic Heritage Fair at Manor Field which was a great success.

Mrs. Hebert acknowledged the Blue Devil Marching Band for a great season so far and wished them good luck in their competition in Syracuse this upcoming weekend.

Mr. Polansky thanked the Booster Club for the golf outing which took place on Columbus Day indicating that all the money raised goes right back into athletics. He also congratulated the Blue Devil Marching band on their outstanding season and wished them well in Syracuse.

Mr. Polansky indicated that the First Lady, Michelle Obama, had lunch with ten of our high school students when she and the President were in town for the debate at Hofstra University. The luncheon was held at Crest Hollow Country Club.

Mr. Polansky thanked the Guidance Department for all their hard work for the 9th Grade Guidance Night held on October 11th.

Mr. Polansky asked everyone to wear something pink on Wednesday, October 24th in memory of those lost to breast cancer and in celebration of the survivors.

On October 29th at Finley LGI there will be a Parent University regarding Dignity for All Students Act. Staff training and student education has been ongoing and we would like parents to also be involved.

There will be two Open Houses at Huntington High School, November 5th and November 17th from 10 to 11 a.m. We will also host a Realtor Open House again this year on November 27th.

There will be a mock ACT exam on 1/12/13.

The HFEE Gala will honor Christine Bené and will be held on January 18th.

1st PUBLIC COMMENTARY

Members of the community were given the opportunity to address the Board of Education on items listed in *Items for Discussion/Action*. There was no public commentary.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

Presentation - Board Recognition Week

Mr. Polansky indicated that this year the High School, Finley and Woodhull Intermediate were asked to put a short program together for Board Recognition Week (October 29th through November 2nd).

Mr. Polansky then presented Mary Stokkers, Principal of Woodhull Intermediate School, who along with Scott Armyn and Christine Barresi, and their Student Council presented the Board with a beautiful banner. Speeches were made by two students in fluent Spanish which illustrated the successful learning which is taking place.

Mr. Amato, Principal of Finley Middle School, presented Finley's Student Council. Speeches were made and the students presented the Board members with certificates and a chocolate bar in appreciation for all they do.

Dr. Leonardi, Principal of Huntington High School, indicated the importance of Student Government at the high school. She then presented Anthony Troffa, high school teacher and one of the advisors for Student Government. Mr. Troffa introduced the high school Student Council members who presented a PowerPoint presentation acknowledging all the time our board members put into the district, showing how much they are appreciated.

Mrs. Mainville then presented the song "Wind Beneath My Wings" sung by the high school chorus.

Mr. Polansky read a proclamation from Governor Andrew Cuomo and presented the board members with a small gift and two certificates of appreciation for their hard work and dedication, one from the Huntington School District and the other from BOCES.

Presentation – <u>Sustainable Long Island</u>

A representative from *Sustainable Long Island* made a presentation and talked about Phase 2 of the Huntington Station Transportation Hub project. There was much discussion and questions from the Board.

Paperless Board Documents

Mr. Polansky discussed the possibility of going paperless for board documents that are routinely sent home to the Board. It was agreed that Mr. Polansky would ask Board Docs to come in to give a demonstration.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)

Mr. Polansky, Dr. Card, Marybeth Robinette, Mrs. Rogan and Mr. DiGiacomo visited a Magnet School in Hartford Connecticut on October 15th. The school is the Annie Fisher STEM Magnet School. They reported that the school was very impressive using an inquiry-based instruction model. The students were engaged and this inner-city school had been turned around in three years' time. Mr. Polansky shared his vision of using Jack Abrams School as such thereby putting the building to good use and bringing the building back to life, and parents would have a choice of sending their children to the school. Grant money would fund the school. Discussion followed and Mr. Polansky will pursue this further indicating it must be cost effective.
