Resolution

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Huntington Union Free School District adopt an opinion that due to the absence of communication from both Avalon Bay and Town Hall, it opposes the currently proposed development due to a high probability of a negative financial impact to the district due to lack of faith in the currently published financial projections.
