REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION HUNTINGTON U.F.S.D.

August 8, 2011

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of the Huntington Union Free School District was held on Monday, August 8, 2011 at Finley Middle School, Greenlawn Road, Huntington, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

There were present Board of Education Members: Rogan, Paci, Black, Brown, Hebert, McGrath, Spector; Christopher Guercio, Esq.; Superintendent Polansky, Dr. Card, Dr. Giani, Mr. Grackin and Mrs. Troffa.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Rogan and seconded by Mr. McGrath to go into Executive Session to discuss negotiations and personnel matters.

MOTION carried 7-0.

At 7:11 p.m. Mrs. Rogan reconvened the meeting.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Rogan led the Board of Education and the others present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Mrs. Rogan discussed the exits to be used in the event of an emergency.

SMOKE-FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT

Mrs. Rogan announced that the Huntington Union Free School District is a smoke-free district and smoking is prohibited in all buildings and on school grounds. She also asked that all cell phones be turned off.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Brown and seconded by Mrs. Hebert to approve the Minutes of the Board of Education Meetings of July 5, 2011 – Regular Meeting and Reorganization Meeting.

MOTION carried 7-0.

COMMUNICATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mrs. Hebert announced an Arts-In-Education fundraiser *Hairspray* at the Engeman Theatre in Northport Village on August 25th.

Mrs. Brown thanked Mrs. Fretz and the teachers and volunteers who put together the summer OOMPAH Arts and Music Program. Mrs. Brown also thanked Mr. Polansky for coordinating the grief counseling after the death of one of our students.

Mr. Polansky indicated that he and Dr. Giani attended a conference in Albany the week of August 1st working with State Education officials on three major things that will be affecting school districts statewide: 1) the Common Core State Standards; 2) the formulation and implementation of school-based inquiry teams to improve student learning outcomes; and 3) the new APPR process. Mr. Polansky touched on some of the highlights of the conference.

PUBLIC COMMENTARY

Members of the community were given the opportunity to address the Board of Education on items on the agenda. Commentary began at 7:16 p.m. and ended at 7:20 p.m.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

Audit Committee Membership Follow-Up

Mr. Polansky discussed that at the last Board of Education meeting there was a question about adding another person to the Audit Committee. Mr. Polansky indicated that the Audit Charter states that there are three members of the Committee, two board members and one community member.

English Language Arts Scope and Sequence – Grades 7 through 10

Dr. Card explained the documents presented to the Board of Education regarding Common Core Standards that New York State is adopting along with 35 other states. Dr. Card explained that the Common Core Standards will ensure that teachers provide consistency and guidance for our students. He indicated the timetable for the implementation. Mr. Polansky elaborated on some of the elements presented and indicated that these standards will be fully implemented by 2013. He indicated that this is a result of Race to the Top funding that the school district received.

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Brown and seconded by Mrs. Hebert to accept the Common Core Math and English Language Arts standards as developed by the Common Core State Standards Initiative.

MOTION carried 7-0.

ShotSpotter Agreement

Mr. Polansky indicated that Suffolk County is very interested in getting us on board with ShotSpotter. He explained that two decisions need to be made. The first is we have to agree that this is the direction we want to go and the second is who will we format the agreement with and what kind of contract do we enter into? Mr. Polansky indicated that three of our school buildings would be involved and that the units would be secured to the buildings. Discussion followed about entering into this contract with the vendor directly or with Suffolk County who would deal with the vendor.

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Hebert and seconded by Mrs. Brown to enter into an intermunicipal cooperative agreement with Suffolk County to install ShotSpotter on three buildings in our district.

MOTION carried 7-0.

Broadcast/Webcast of Board of Education Meetings

Mr. Polansky opened the discussion about broadcasting board meetings live or taping them and putting them on our website. The Board decided that they would like to investigate the options that are available.

CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Brown and seconded by Mrs. Hebert to authorize administration to arrange for the provision of appropriate special education programs and services for students as enumerated in the CSE and CPSE minutes:
