NOMINATING PETITIONS

February 22, 2013

Nominating petitions must be signed by at least 60 “qualified” district voters. A person need not be a registered voter to sign the petition. A “qualified” voter is a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old and a “resident” of the school district for at least 30 days prior to the election at which he or she seeks to vote.

Petitions must be returned to the District Clerk’s Office at Jack Abrams School no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, April 22.

Drawing of lots will be at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23 in the District Clerk’s office at Jack Abrams School.

SUBJECT: BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS: QUALIFICATIONS

A Board of Education member of the Huntington Union Free School District must meet the following qualifications:

- a) A citizen of the United States;
- b) Eighteen (18) years of age or older;
- c) Able to read and write;
- d) A legal resident one (1) year prior to the election;
- e) Cannot be an employee of the Huntington Union Free School District;
- f) The only member of his/her family (that is, cannot be a member of the same household) on the Huntington Union Free School District Board;
- g) May not simultaneously hold another, incompatible public office;
- h) Must not have been removed from a school district office within one year preceding the date of election to the Board.
