As you may be aware, the Huntington Union Free School District is considering the establishment of a STEM Magnet School in the Jack Abrams building. The program can best be defined as follows:

STEM – All disciplines taught, however the curriculum would be centered upon science, technology, engineering and mathematics, with a focus on inquiry-based instructional strategies.

Magnet – School with no specific attendance zone. Huntington students would apply for enrollment and would be selected via lottery.

The school would initially target students in grades 3 – 5 and would be targeted for opening in September of 2013 or 2014.

At this time, we are simply attempting to determine a sense of interest within the school community. If you are a parent or guardian of a student currently in grades 1 – 4 and might potentially be interested in enrolling your child in such a program, please do one of the following:
