

HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL 2013 SPRING DRIVER EDUCATION APPLICATION

The Huntington Union Free School District Spring Driver Education Program is currently open to any student who has reached the age of 16 by February 2, 2013 and holds a valid learner's permit. **Registration for the 2013 Spring Session will be held on January 28th from 2:30 – 3:30pm for Seniors ('13) only in Room 122 at the High School. ***January 29th, from 2:30pm – 3:30pm, registration for all other students in Room 122 at the High School.** Juniors ('14) will register first then Sophomores ('15), then all others. There are 70 openings which will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

The course will run from February 4th through May 11th. One hour lecture classes will be conducted on Mondays and Tuesdays, students must attend both days. Road Classes will be conducted Monday through Friday and Saturdays, students must attend one road class per week which are two hour sessions. More detailed information is on the back of this page. **Individual schedules will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis on the day of registration.**

Students may ONLY miss a total of three classes. However, all missed classes must be made up immediately. If a student is involved in extra curricular activities (athletics, SAT courses, etc.) they must check their schedules to make sure they will have no more than 3 conflicts. Once a student misses the **fourth** class, they will be dropped from the program and will not be eligible for a BLUE CARD (MV-285). **CLASSES CANNOT BE MADE UP ONCE A NEW SEMESTER BEGINS.** Therefore, it is extremely important that a firm commitment be made as to a student's attendance. Also, please note that it is the student's responsibility to provide transportation to and from the program. Please be advised that the registration fee of \$500.00 (Resident) and \$525.00 (Non-Resident) will not be refunded once the program has begun.
