# Advanced Placement

- The Huntington High School Advanced placement program offers students an opportunity to take courses taught on a college level.
- Intensive classroom work, independent study and research are an integral part of the program.
- AP exams are administered by the College Entrance Examination Board and a 5 point college level scale is used. According to the College Board's publication, over 1,000 colleges and universities will grant advanced placement credit to candidates who have composite grades of 4 or 5.
- Students enrolled in an AP course **must** sit for the AP exam.



# AP Costs

The cost of taking AP examinations is absorbed by the student. The examination is administered by the College Entrance Board. Payment for each exam must be made by the end of the first marking period.

# College Board Information

## Huntington High School AP Statistics

- **AP Scholar:** grades of 3 or higher on 3 or more AP exams.
- **AP Scholar with Honor:** average grade of at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on 4 or more exams.
- **AP Scholar with Distinction:** average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on 5 or more exams.
- **National AP Scholar:** an average grade of at least 4 on all AP exams taken and grades of 4 or higher on 8 or more of these exams.
