Dear Parents,

Halloween is fast approaching! As per past years, I ask for your support in making the upcoming holiday celebration a safe time for all students attending Huntington High School. It has been our experience that students enjoy dressing up and having fun with their classmates and friends. Several of our staff members have joined in the fun.

This year students will once again be permitted to come to school in respectable costumes with some use of make-up allowed. **NO MASKS OR PROPS** will be permitted. I ask that during the days preceding Halloween you discuss this matter with your child and inform him or her that such things as “fresh or frozen” eggs, water balloons, water bottles, shaving cream, fire crackers, imitation (toy) weapons (such as swords, knives, guns, chains, etc.) will not be allowed into the school building. If students are found in possession of props that can be deemed unsafe, they will be taken away from them and you will be contacted to come to the school to pick them up and escort your child home for the day. Please remember that pranks that jeopardize the safety of students and adults are subject to more severe consequences.

I know from past experience that students in attendance will enjoy the day and be most cooperative. Your help in talking to your son or daughter about issues stated above will certainly enhance that enjoyment. As a reminder, our students will be sponsoring SAFE HALLOWEEN for the children of the community from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 31, 2011. Students will not be allowed on school property after the conclusion of the Safe Halloween activities.
