**JAGODA SCHOLARSHIP in memory of Jake and Mary Jagoda, who was a graduate of Huntington High School. Both Mary and Jake had a passion for living and for learning, especially history. A fitting remembrance for them is a scholarship that will offer Huntington High School graduates the opportunity to pursue their dreams. The criteria are: academic excellence with an emphasis on history courses, declaring a college major in history, or a related field, an essay, "History Is My Passion" and a recommendation from the social studies department. DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**HUNTINGTON LIONS CLUB will award one \$5,000 scholarship (\$625 per semester) to a high school senior who is a resident of the Huntington School District. Criteria are financial need and service to the community and school. DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL PTSA will award \$500 scholarships to three seniors who have shown outstanding academic improvement during high school and have demonstrated good citizenship and character and show financial need. DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**JOEL H. COHEN AND SELMA D. COHEN VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP to a deserving Huntington High School senior planning to attend some type of vocational school or a two year college in a vocational program rather than a traditional college or university program. The recipient must have also been involved in sports at the community or high school level DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**ASSOCIATED TEACHERS OF HUNTINGTON will award a \$1,000 scholarship to an individual who plans to become a teacher on the elementary or secondary level. The award is based on financial need and scholastic achievement. DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP awarded by the Alumni Association to a Huntington High School senior going on to college, one or both of whose parents are graduates of Huntington High School. The selection of the student is not solely based on academic excellence, although it is taken into consideration. The award is for all-around character and a willingness to help others. DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>**

**HOWARD MUNSON SCHOLARSHIP** given to a student who will be continuing his/her education at a vocational school. First preference should be given to a student in an automotive or mechanical field. If there is no student continuing their education in these fields, it may be awarded to a student in another vocation. **DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**JAMES A. LOEBELL SCHOLARSHIP** offers two awards of \$1,000 to a Huntington High School senior primarily based on school and community service. **DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**HUNTINGTON ROTARY CLUB** will award three scholarships totaling \$12,000 to Huntington High School seniors planning to attend college, who are actively involved in school and community service. **DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**CARMELA SANTORSOLA PROVENZANO SCHOLARSHIP** of \$1,000 to a Huntington High School senior with a minimum GPA of 93%, financial need also a factor. **DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**

**FRANCES BIFULCO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** for learning disabled students wishing to attend college. Selection will be based on an essay regarding overcoming obstacles and future goals. **DEADLINE IS MAY 6<sup>TH</sup>.**
