

SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2011-12

Southdown Primary School

Please send in all materials on the first day of school.

Please note that many of these items will be shared as a class. We have found that the community system works very well with many of the supplies. It is not necessary to label everything, only what is noted as "labeled".

- 1 large backpack (without wheels) labeled with name
- 1 soft pencil case with zipper
- 40 **sharpened #2 yellow** pencils with extra eraser tops* (Ticonderoga pencils are best) and 2 extra erasers
- 1 manual pencil sharpener
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 count)*
- 2 boxes of colored pencils*
- 2 boxes of "fine tip" washable markers
- 4 black *Sharpie* markers (fine point)
- 4 black and 4 blue thin Dry Erase markers with eraser tips (Expos are best)
- 10 glue sticks *
- 5 different color composition notebooks labeled with name (**NO SPIRALS**)
 - 1 red, 1 purple, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 black
- 3 bottom pocket folders labeled with name
- 1 pair of children's scissors labeled with name (Fiskars are best)
- 1 cm and inch ruler (to keep at home for homework)
- 1 package of post-it notes (3x3 preferred)
- 1 one-inch 3 ring binder
- Looseleaf paper

*The following items will need to be replenished throughout the year. You may want to buy a bigger quantity in the summer and keep them in a safe place.

- pencils, glue sticks, eraser tops, colored pencils, crayons

Many times parents generously ask to make donations to the classroom. Below are some frequently used items. Any contributions are welcome.

- "soft" tissues-gentler on the nose ☺
- Ziploc bags (gallon or quart size)
