A Reminder from the School Nurse to all 6th Grade Parents

All 6th Grade students are required by New York State to have a pertussis booster, called Tdap, once they turn 11 years of age. The vaccination is available thru your child's pediatrician or you may call the Dolan Family Health Center at 631-425-5250 for an appointment at their Immunization Clinic.

If you have recently received a letter concerning this matter, that means that you child health record indicates that he/she is still in need of this vaccination. Please send in proof of the TDAP vaccination as soon as possible to avoid you child being excluded from school as of January 25th, 2013.
