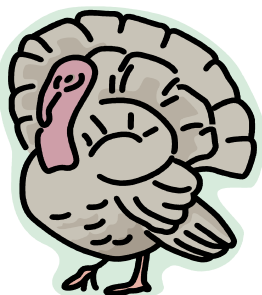

The words we introduced so far are: impact, demonstrate, concept, construct, criteria, analysis, affect, previous, primary, relevant, sequence, specific, significant, anticipate and analogy.
