

Director's Notes

Going *into the woods* can be scary—a foreboding place where we will encounter darkness, strange creatures, and other elements unknown to us. Or as in Shakespeare, is it a magical place where anything is possible—love and redemption, a locale where all that was once wrong may now be put right. One of the ideas that lies at the center of the play is the warning—be careful what you wish for, you might get it. In our heart of hearts isn't there something we long for, yearn for, need—a dream or hope that keeps us moving forward though it is seemingly unattainable? What is it we seek—fame, fortune, status, and love, a child—a wish—to fill a void in our hearts and minds—a search for that missing piece of the puzzle to make us whole? That is just what each character goes *into the woods* to achieve and we see how it affects them as people. Some rise above their shortcomings, some fall victim to their needs, and some are forced to grow up too quickly. What choices might we have made were we in their shoes? Are they victims or victimizers? Each must live with the decisions they have made as we must live with the decisions we make every day. They live in a fairy tale—we live in the real world. What have we wrought on others and they on us? Something to think about.
