REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION HUNTINGTON U.F.S.D.

February 8, 2010

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of the Huntington Union Free School District was held on Monday, February 8, 2010 at Jack Abrams Intermediate School, Lowndes Avenue, Huntington Station, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Rogan and seconded by Mr. McGrath to go into Executive Session to discuss contract negotiations.

A parent and resident read a statement regarding 300 Nassau Road and the presentation made by the architects at the previous board meeting.

Mrs. Evers, Principal of Jefferson Primary School, thanked Bobby and Amy Oliva, owners of Joanina's Restaurant and Laura Fischer, all Huntington graduates who hosted a fundraiser to benefit Jefferson Primary School. Mrs. Oliva then addressed the Board of Education and presented a check in the amount of \$4,800. The Board of Education expressed their gratitude.
