



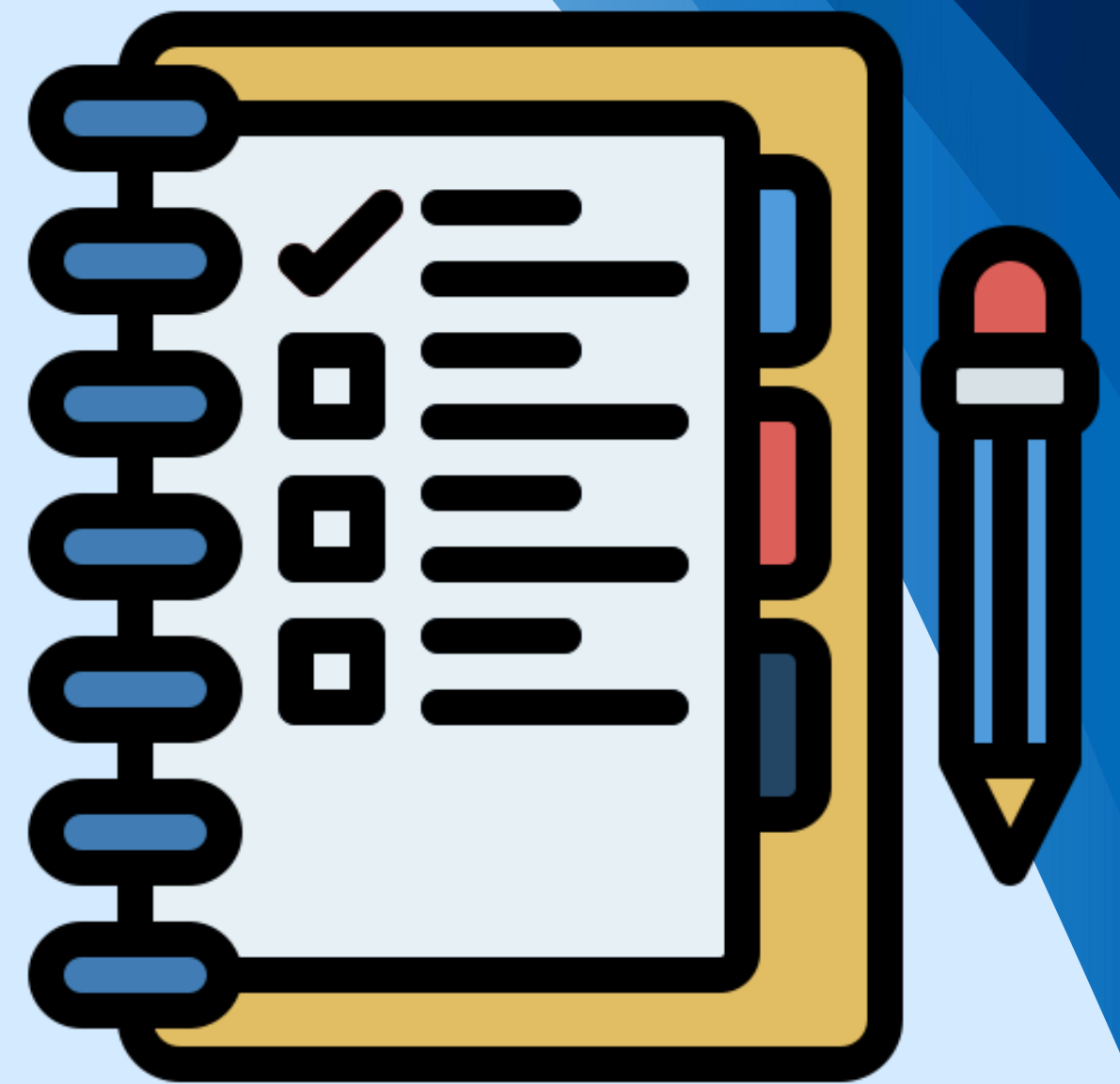

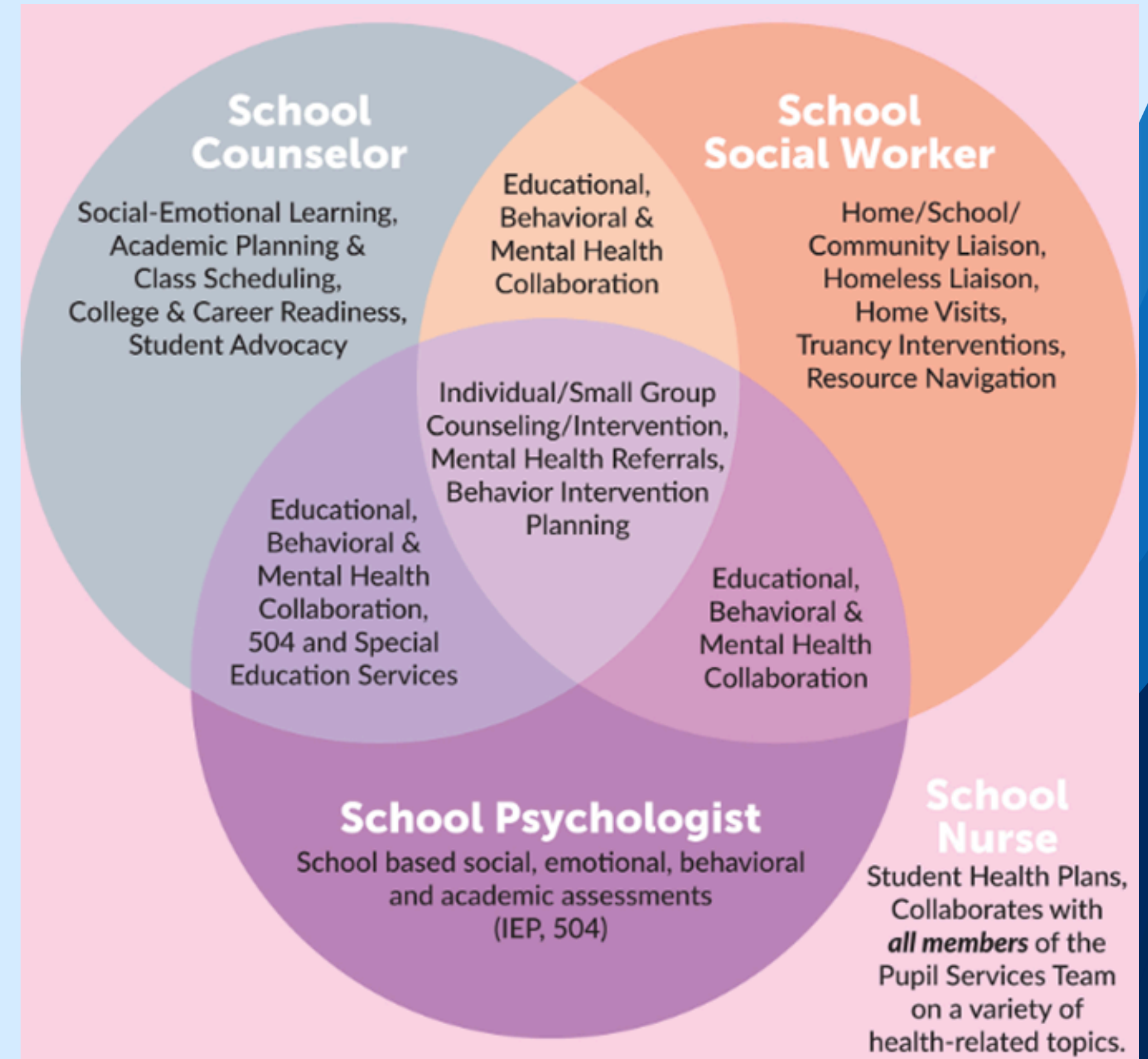

High School Level Courses

High School-Level Courses Offered at J.Taylor Finley Middle School (Grade 8)

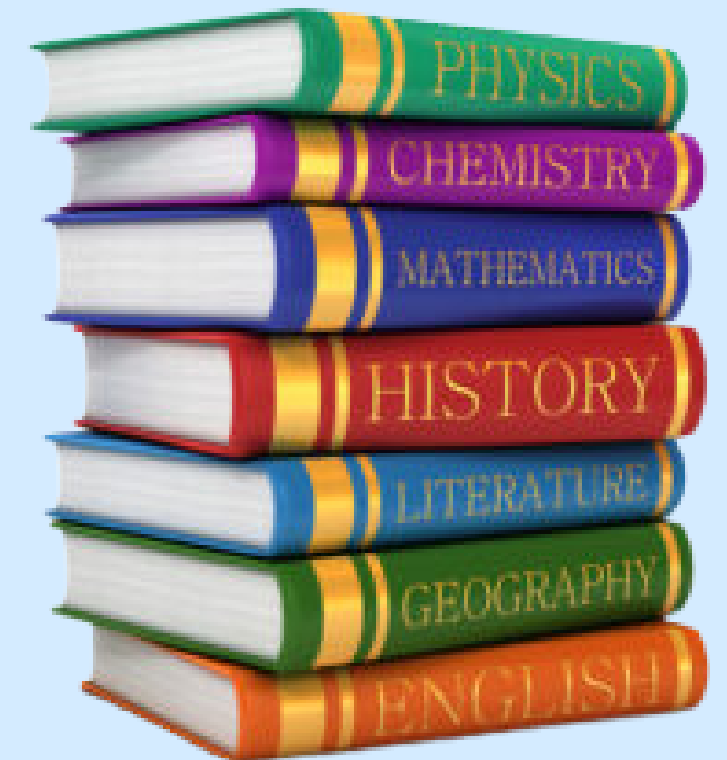
Science: Earth and Space Science – (Regents Exam at the end of the course)

Art: Accelerated Studio in Art

Math: Algebra I - All Students (Regents Exam at the end of the course)

World Language: Spanish, French, Italian, or Latin

Benefits: Students can earn up to four high school course credits



Scheduling Process for Grade 6

World Language Selections:

- Woodhull Intermediate School: Students will continue with their current World Language Selection; No Changes will be permitted.
- Jack Abrams STEM Intermediate School: World Language Clubs have been visiting classes at Jack Abrams Stem Intermediate School to provide students with information regarding World Language Course Offerings.

Fine & Performing Arts:

- Students will be scheduled for either Art or Music, but they will not be able to take both during the same Academic Year.
 - Music Selections: Band, Chorus, Orchestra, or General Music

Scheduling Process for Grade 6

Course Selections:

- Course selections from parents are due by January 23, 2026 .
- Ms. Handschu will meet with students individually to review course selections and academic progress. Afterwards, entries are completed in eSchool.

Student Schedules Released:

- Course placements and schedules will be posted on the parent portal and the student Portal in August.

Assist Students in Setting S.M.A.R.T. Goals:

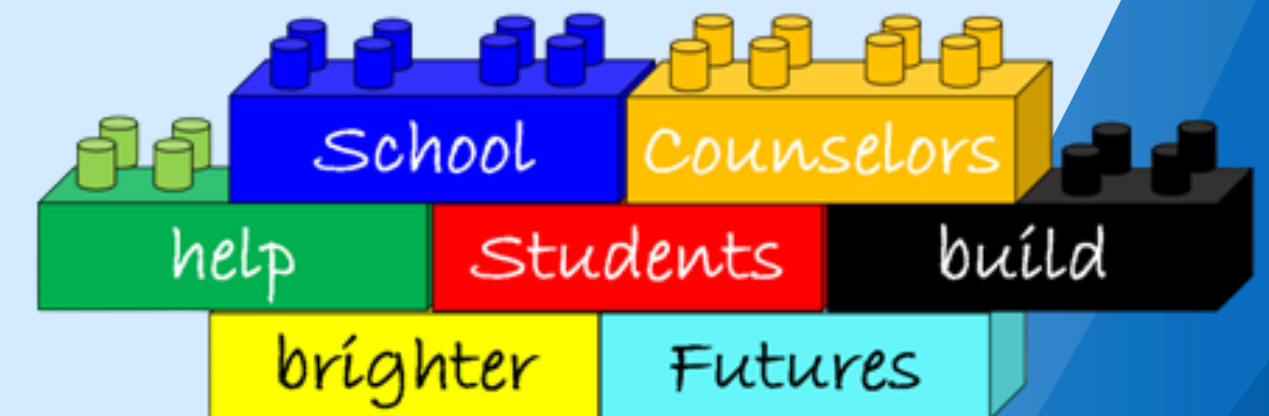
- Guide students to establish Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, and Time-Bound goals, and help them create action plans to achieve those goals.

Planning for the Future

(College and Career Readiness)

High School Course Registration and Credits: Students enrolled in high school-level courses earn credits toward their diploma, with all courses also appearing on the official high school transcript.

Continued Dual Language Studies: Dual Language students maintain their language proficiency by continuing language courses throughout high school.

Transcripted Grades and Credits from Grade 7: Both the final course grade and credits earned in grade 7, along with the Checkpoint B exam grade, are recorded on the student's high school transcript.

Career Exploration through Naviance: Career exploration programs are introduced in grade 7 via the Naviance platform, helping students begin to plan and explore future career pathways.

Parent and Student Portal

Benefits:

- **Real-Time Access to Information:** Provides up-to-date attendance, grades, schedules, and progress reports.
- **Improved Communication:** Strengthens parent-teacher-student collaboration with instant updates and messaging features.
- **Academic Monitoring:** Enables parents and students to track assignments, grades, and graduation requirements.
- **Empowerment:** Encourages students to take accountability and actively participate in their academic journey.
