LINNEA WONG (Policeman/Ensemble) is so excited to be a part of *42nd Street*! She hopes you enjoy the show.

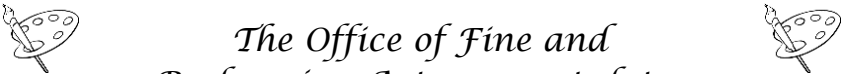

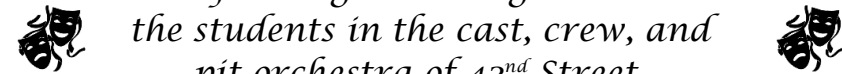
