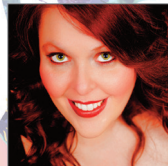

## Director’s Notes

*Seussical* – the show people love to hate. Is it the story? Is it the music? Is it Seuss? Admittedly, before we started the rehearsal process, I myself was a naysayer, now I consider *Seussical* the show I learned to love. Once I began to work on the show, the things I thought suddenly began to change – it was more than a group of Dr. Seuss characters thrown together singing songs. Horton and JoJo sit at the center of our story, both outcasts from society –or is Horton just a manifestation of JoJo’s imagination? – Horton for believing when no one else would and JoJo for thinking his “thinks.” Both characters could have easily rolled over and conformed to society in order to be accepted, instead they stick with their beliefs when everyone is against them.

Throughout literature we have witnessed characters that had to stand alone when everyone around them either doubted or vilified them for their choices or beliefs. Atticus Finch in *To Kill a Mockingbird*, Ralph in *Lord of the Flies*, or Holden Caulfield in *The Catcher in the Rye* – all either mocked or unaccepted by society, all willing to stand up for themselves and what they believe in – are characters that we hold in esteem, beloved in books that people love to hate. I also find it interesting that the music and lyrics are by the same team that gave us *Ragtime* – another story of a man willing to stand alone for what he believes is right. When you scratch the surface of *Seussical* there’s more there than meets the eye – give us a chance and you might learn to love it too – Somethink to think about.

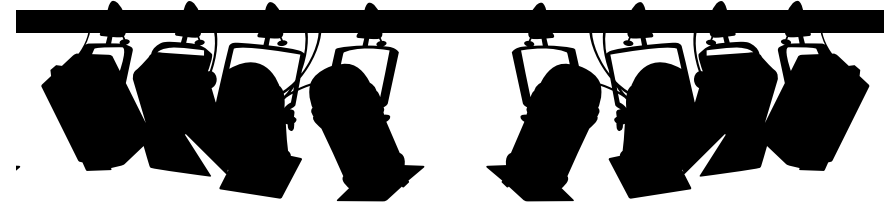

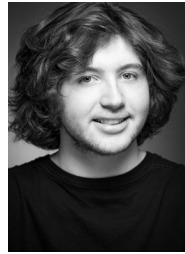
**JAKE AMEND** (Ensemble) is so excited to be a part of *Seussical!* It has been such a great time being in the musical and he can't wait for people to come see it.

very entertaining! She hopes you feel the embers from this exciting show!



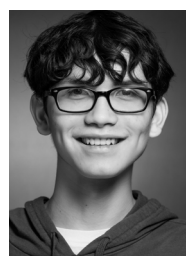

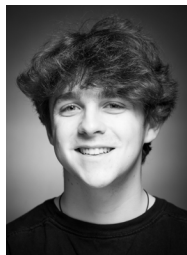

School District. Sophia loves working with Schwen and the cast of *Seussical*. She would like to thank everyone who has made this opportunity possible.



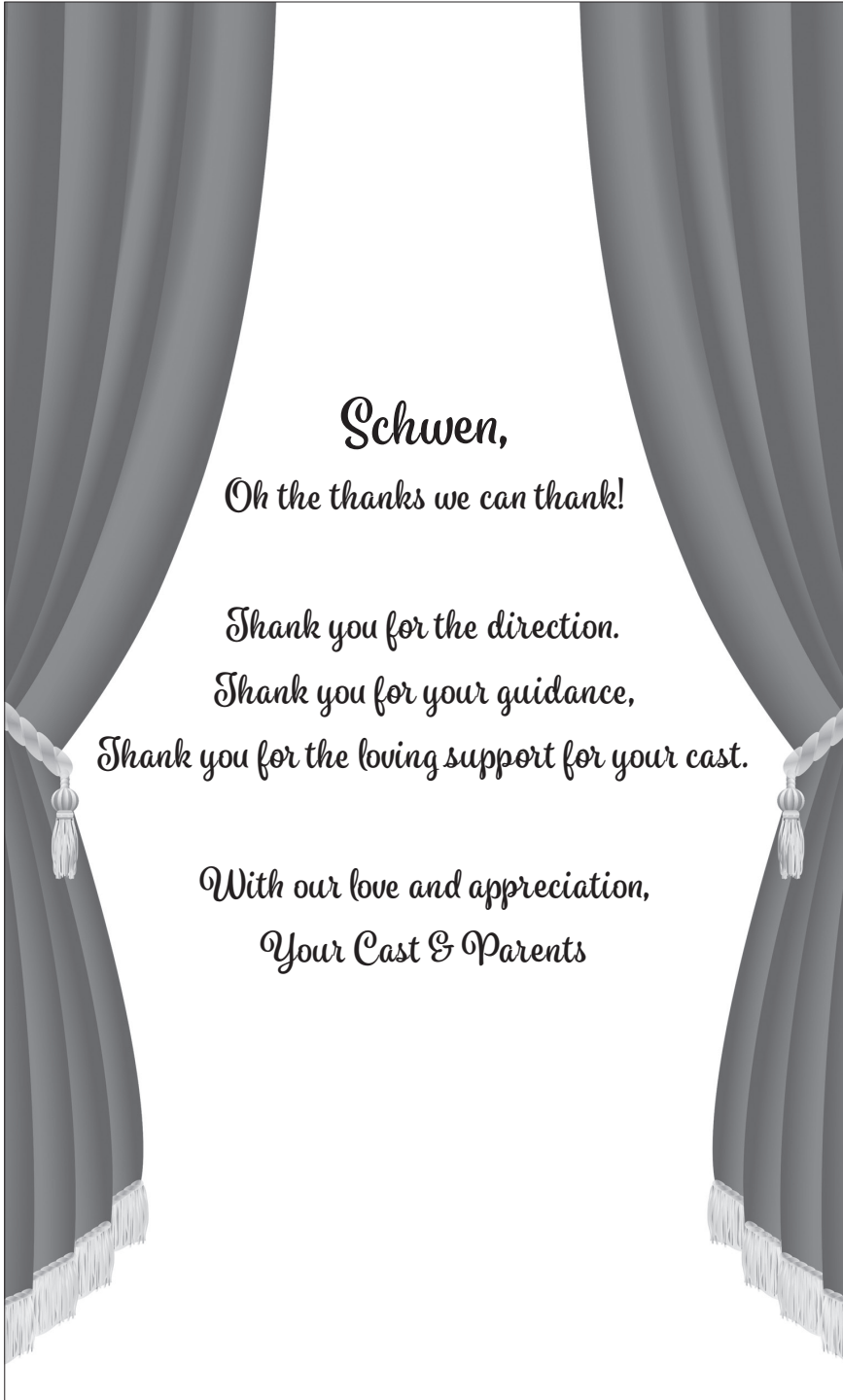

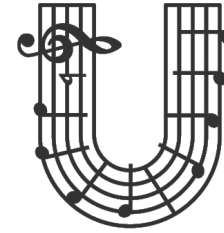
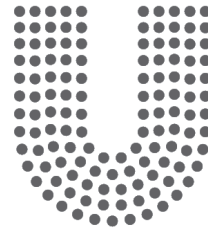
