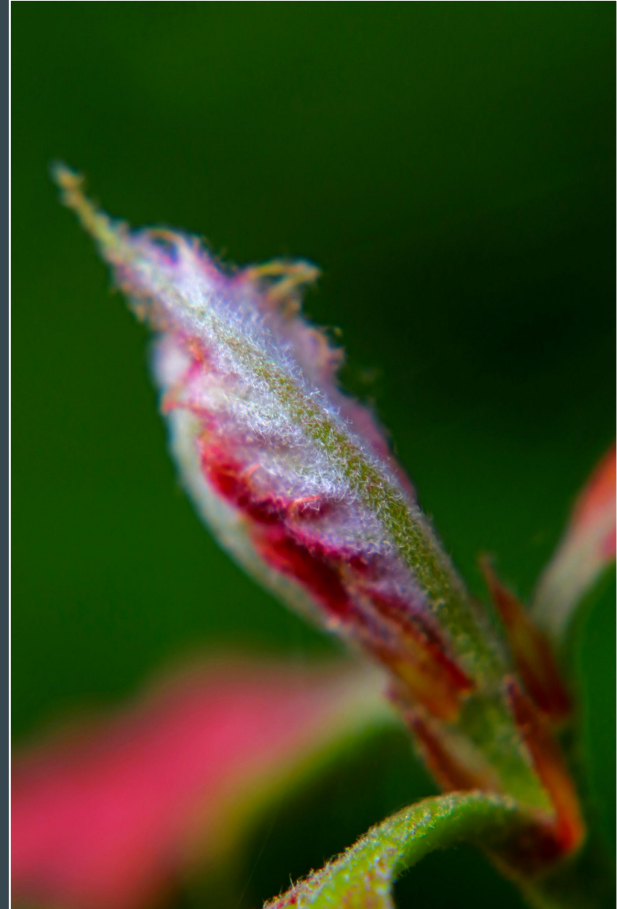
# Reese Rinaldi
