2025-2026 School Based Team Goals

SMART Goal # 1:

Increase parent engagement through expanded communication pathways and offer opportunities for students and families to share cultural backgrounds and make connections.

Action Plan

- Expand Cultural Expo & Gallery Walk to include a family fashion show of traditional clothing.
 We will also seek to engage more families by hosting a daytime event where families can share
 their own culture in small class presentations. In class students will explore different
 countries/cultures from around the world. Each class will make a representation of their
 learning. Students will engage in a grade level gallery walk followed by a parent event.
- Welcome class parents to assist in celebrations of holidays and to support instructional opportunities
- Continue to provide targeted parent engagement evenings, PBIS activities and Community Circles (i.e. RTI Game Night)
- Expand student communication of upcoming events Students are great communicators with their families. Our goal is to make sure students are informed of all upcoming events. We will do this by:
 - Use of lobby and lunch room TV advertisements
 - o Update Student Council Bulletin board with upcoming events
 - o Student Council President and Vice President will create a video of upcoming events that will be shared with each teacher
 - Teachers will promote awareness of upcoming events by playing the student council video
 - Newspaper club will create a one-page "Here is what is happening..." notice to be shared with students
 - o Ensure that student council representatives are given 5-10 minutes following each student council meeting to share what they are working on
 - o Increase signage at arrival and dismissal to spread the word about upcoming events.

SMART Goal #2:

Action Plan
