HONOREE 2017

THE HONORABLE W. GERARD ASHER



The Honorable W. Gerard Asher is better known to his friends and family in the Town of Huntington as "Jerry." Although he is widely recognized throughout New York State as a Supreme Court Judge, his roots run deep in the Huntington Community as an athlete, a leader, and a thoroughly engaged and proactive citizen.

While a Blue Devil, Jerry was the starting point guard on the '57-'58 Suffolk County championship basketball team. Then, as a senior, he was captain and quarterback of the football team that was a co-champion of Suffolk County. He also captained the basketball team in '58-'59, played varsity baseball and lacrosse and earned eight varsity letters. In addition, he was Senior Class President and played the saxophone in two rock and roll bands.

Jerry attended Princeton University where he participated in football and lacrosse, majored in History, and was a member of Cannon Club on which he now serves on the Board of Directors. Upon his graduation from Princeton, he was commissioned in the U.S. Army, but was deferred while studying law at Cornell. After graduating from law school and being admitted to the bar, he served two years in the U.S. Army.

Jerry spent a year in Korea where as a Captain, he was a Commander of a Hawk Missile Battery, and was awarded the Army Commendation Medal for his service. He is a lifetime member of VFW Post 1469.

In 1969, Jerry returned to Huntington and began a general practice of law. He served on numerous Suffolk County Bar Association committees, received two Pro Bono awards, served on the Suffolk County Bar Association Board of Directors and was President of the Huntington Lawyer's Club in '82-'83. During his thirty-six year career as an attorney, Jerry was involved in numerous community, charitable, and governmental organizations. These included his forty-six year membership in Kiwanis where he was twice a distinguished president, served as a director of the Huntington Township Chamber of Commerce, President of the Jaycees, Chairman of the Site Selection Committee for challenged persons, Chairman of the Suffolk Legislature Redistricting Committee,

and several blue ribbon committees for the Town of Huntington. In 1984, he was a recipient of a Congressional Achievement Award for outstanding service to the community of Long Island. Jerry was also a member of the Town of Huntington Planning Board for seventeen years.

Jerry's involvement in the world of sports continued as he played in men's basketball and softball leagues, spent a year as a running back with the semi-pro Huntington Giants, and seven years as their General Manager. He was a television host of a sports call-in show for the Huntington Cable Six for several years and did the high school game of the week as an analyst. At present, Jerry is one of three people who have run every Great Cow Harbor 10K race for the past forty years.


In 1982, Jerry became associated with Tony Attanasio, a well respected Major League baseball agent. As a certified MLBPA agent, he prepared and argued many salary arbitration cases and objections on the collusion distributions for over thirty major league baseball players. Of the many professional baseball players he represented over the years, some of the locals included Bud Harrelson, Neil Allen, Lee Mazzilli, Rafael Santana, Shane Rawley, Tim Teufel, and Jon Searles.

In 2004, Jerry was elected as a Judge of the District Court from Huntington and tried numerous criminal matters. In 2009, he was honored by the Suffolk County Criminal Bar Association as "Judge of the Year." In 2010 he was elected Justice of the Supreme Court and has served in a civil trial part with emphasis on complicated medical malpractice cases. Jerry will be retiring at the end of this year since, at seventy-six, it is mandated by New York State Law.

In 1963, Jerry married his high school sweetheart, Sylvia, and they raised two beautiful and caring daughters, Gigi and Lara. The family are members of St. Elizabeth's R.C. Church, where Jerry serves as a lector and Eucharistic Minister. He also serves as a trustee of St. Anthony's High School.

The Booster Club is pleased to honor Jerry for his long time service to our community and for his enduring support of all Blue Devil sports.











