## **HUNTINGTON HS - 2018 FALL DRIVER EDUCATION APPLICATION**

The Huntington Union Free School District Fall Driver Education Program is open to any student who has reached the age of 16 by September 1, 2018 and holds a valid learner's permit. **Registration for the 2018 Fall Session will be:** 

September 5<sup>th</sup> HHS Seniors ('19) and Juniors ('20) 2:30 – 3:30pm in Room 122 (Seniors will register first, then Juniors)

September 6<sup>th</sup> HHS Sophomores ('21) and \*All Others 2:30 – 3:30pm in Room 122 (Sophomores will register first, then All Others)

\*All Others = students not attending Huntington HS and Non-Residents

There are 70 openings which will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. The course will run from September 17<sup>th</sup> through December 21<sup>st</sup>. Lecture classes will be conducted on Mondays and Tuesdays, students must attend both days. Students must attend one road class per week. Individual schedules will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis on the day of registration. Due to the number of days that the school will be closed this Fall please review the course calendar that will be issued at registration for specific lecture and road class dates.

Students may ONLY miss a total of three classes. However, all missed classes must be made up immediately. If the students needs to make-up more than one road class due to absences, they <u>may</u> be required to pay for any additional road make-up classes. If a student is involved in extra-curricular activities (athletics, marching band, SAT courses, etc.) they must check their schedules to make sure they will have no more than 3 conflicts. Once a student misses the **fourth** class, they will be dropped from the program and will not be eligible for a BLUE CARD (MV-285). **CLASSES CANNOT BE**MADE UP ONCE A NEW SEMESTER BEGINS. Therefore, it is extremely important that a firm commitment be made as to a student's attendance. Also, please note that it is the student's responsibility to provide transportation to and from the program. Please be advised that the registration fee of \$500.00 (Resident) and \$525.00 (Non-Resident) will not be refunded once the program has begun. Please make checks payable to: **HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM.** The district will provide the MV-285 form to the student once all requirements are fulfilled. To replace a lost MV-285, it will cost an additional \$25.00.
