FIRST OFFENSE

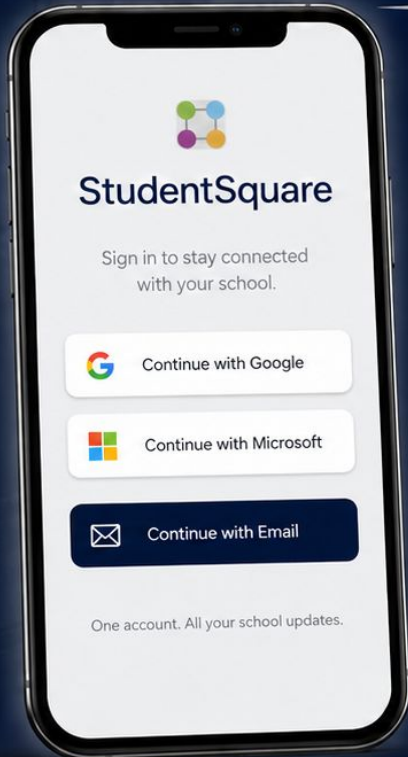
