The main focus of these camps is to offer summer recreation for the Huntington community and to build interest and enthusiasm in the Huntington sports programs. We have funded grants for the baseball, basketball, crew, lacrosse, spring track, soccer, softball ,tennis and wrestling programs. We have also purchased a scoreboard and scorer table for Finley Middle School. Every coach at the High School and Finley are eligible to submit a grant. We are looking forward to another great year.
