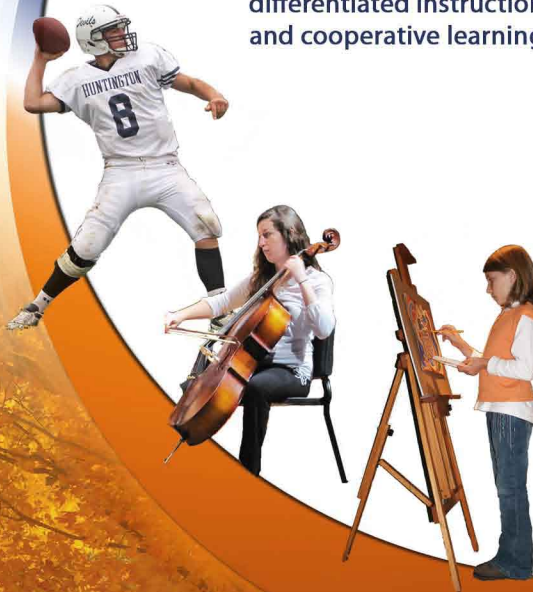




- 90% of our students graduate with a Regents or Advanced Regents Diplomas.
