August 24, 2009

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of the Huntington Union Free School District was held on Monday, August 24, 2009 at J. Taylor Finley Middle School, Greenlawn Road, Huntington, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m.

ROLL CALL

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A MOTION was made by Mr. McGrath and seconded by Mrs. Rogan to go into Executive Session to discuss contract issues and negotiations.

COMMUNICATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mrs. Rogan reported on the NYSSBA Conference that she and Mr. Dwyer attended. The topic was "Policy and Effective School Board Meetings."

As discussed at a prior board meeting, Mrs. Rogan indicated that if any board member wanted to learn more about the master scheduling, Mr. Noce is available. Discussion followed about scheduling a meeting with Mr. Noce. It was decided that those members of the board who are able to will meet Mr. Noce on Thursday, August 27, 2009 at 4 p.m. Mrs. Rogan will confirm with Mr. Noce.

Mrs. Rogan brought up the idea of the board participating in Board Retreats run by NYSSBA. The purpose would be for the Board to meet in a non-boardroom setting to listen to speakers from NYSSBA. The topics would be selected by the Board. Discussion followed. The Board was in favor and Mrs. Rogan will get more information.

Mrs. Brown commented that a mural in Huntington Village by Waldbaums was painted by students from the eight school districts in the Township of Huntington, including students from our district. Tri-CYA sponsored the program and worked with the artists.

PUBLIC COMMENTARY

At the portion of the meeting set aside for public commentary the following comments were made:

A parent and PTSA executive board member had concerns about the parking lot at the high school and that it was not yet completed. She also had concerns about the vacant position of Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction. Mr. Dwyer responded that these issues will be addressed at this board meeting.

A band parent thanked Mr. Grackin and Mr. Rispoli and their staff for all their hard work in support of band camp this summer.

A resident expressed concerns about the Guidance position that has remained vacant. Mr. Dwyer asked that she refrain from further comment as this is a personnel issue.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

2009-2010 Board of Education Goals

Mr. Dwyer reviewed the draft goals as set forth at the board meeting of August 3, 2009. He opened the floor for discussion before any action was taken. Some discussion followed.

Goals of the Board of Education 2009-2010

- 1. Develop a two year District financial plan taking into consideration the need for capital improvements and anticipated future reductions in State and Federal funding.
- 2. Develop a schedule whereby the High School and Middle School Principals and District Directors will report to the Board of Education at least once a year on academic progress

within their school or discipline. Include a report from the Executive Director of Special Education and Student Support Services on Special Education Indicators regarding disproportionality.

- 3. Develop a multi year instructional technology plan.
- 4. Develop a plan to house the expanding elementary dual language program.
- 5. Develop a concrete plan to address the critical issues regarding space in all schools.

A MOTION was made by Mrs. Bené and seconded by Mrs. Rogan to approve the Board of Education Goals for the 2009-2010 year.

MOTION carried.

Tour of Facilities

Mr. Grackin indicated that annually the Board of Education is required to tour building facilities each year according the Commissioner of Education Regulations. Discussion followed and a time and date was set for September 3, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. The Board will meet Mr. Finello and Mr. Grackin and begin the tour at Abrams Intermediate School.

Summer Facilities Projects Update

Mr. Grackin stated that much work had been accomplished over the summer in the various school buildings under the supervision of Paul Rispoli, Al White and George Austin. He detailed all the projects in each school. Mr. Finello commended Mr. Grackin and his Facilities staff for all their hard work and all that had been accomplished. Mr. Dwyer also thanked Mr. Grackin and Mr. Rispoli.
